***BACKGROUND***

This information is presented in order to better and more systematically apprise the Council of final action by the Board of County Commissioners/Countywide Planning Authority on matters that have been considered by the Council.

**At their May 5, 2009 meeting, the CPA took the following actions:**

**Public Hearings**

**Subthreshold Amendments:**

- Case CW 09-04, a Pinellas County case located with one area of approximately 2.3 acres are north of Old Keystone Road and north of the Upper Pinellas Youth Sport Complex. The remaining areas are approximately 14.1 acres in size and south of Keystone Road and east of East Lake Road. All of this amendment area is within the Brooker Creek Preserve. The Board **approved** the amendment from Recreation/Open Space, Residential Rural, Residential Low, and No Designation to Preservation (vote 6-0).

**SUBJECT:** Consent Agenda: II C. Countywide Planning Authority Actions

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**Regular Amendments:**

- Case CW 09-05, a Pinellas County case of approximately 948 acres located north of Old Keystone Road extending north to the Pinellas-Pasco county line. The remaining 1,660 acres are south of Keystone Road, along the Pinellas-Hillsborough county line on the east and extending south to the Oldsmar city limits. All of this amendment area is within the Brooker Creek Preserve. The Board **approved** the amendment in its entirety from Preservation to Preservation with Resource Management Overlay (vote 6-1).
- Case CW 09-06, a Pinellas County case located north of Keystone Road, along the Pinellas-Hillsborough county line on the east and extending north to the Pinellas-Pasco county line. This area is commonly referred to as the “Wilde Trust” parcel. The Board **approved** the amendment from Residential Rural and Transportation/Utility to Preservation with Resource Management Overlay, Preservation with Transportation/Utility Overlay, and Recreation/Open Space (vote 6-1).
- Case CW 09-07, a City of Tarpon Springs case located at 615, 625, and 631 North Jasmine Avenue. The Board **approved** the amendment from Residential Urban, Preservation, and Preservation with Transportation/Utility Overlay to Industrial Limited, Preservation, and Preservation with Transportation/Utility Overlay (vote 5-2).
